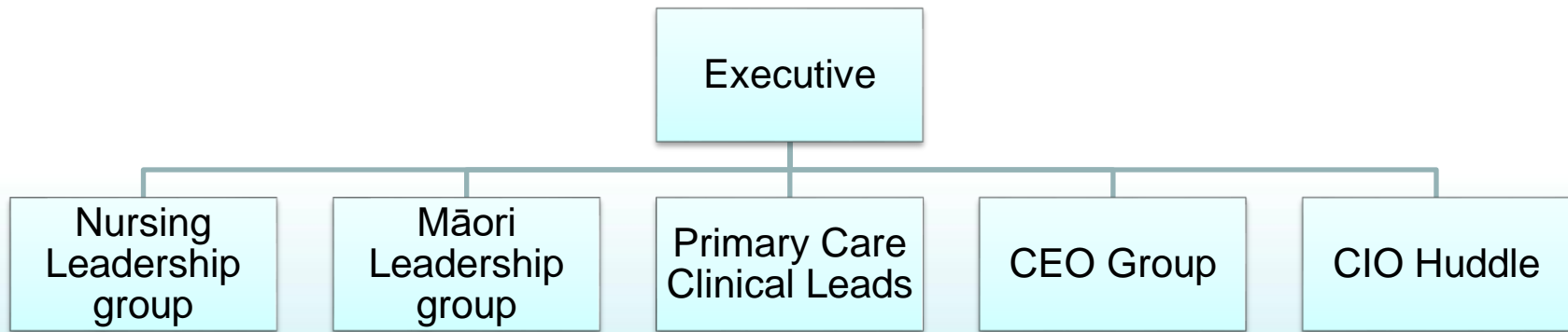

The Contracting Environment

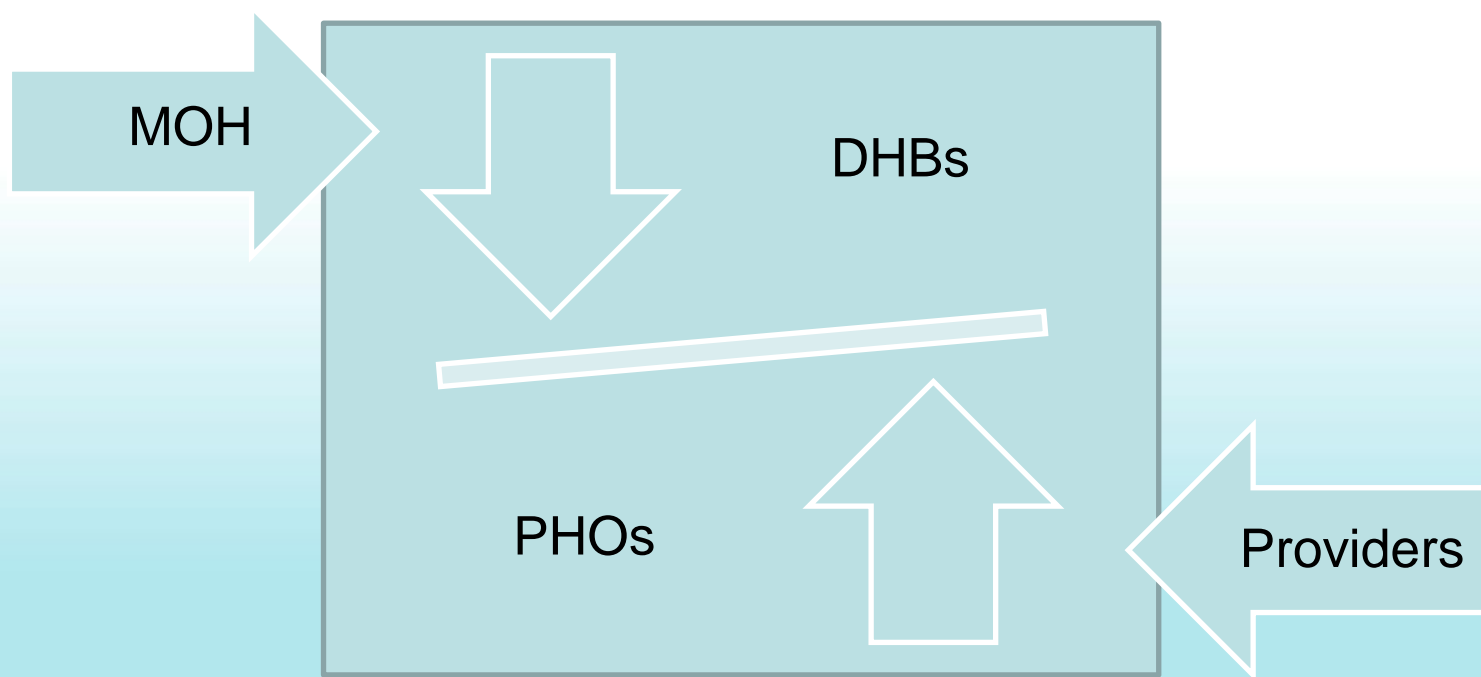
PSAAP is the forum that has the mandate to agree changes to the Primary Health Organisation (PHO) Services Agreement.

And ONLY the PHO Services Agreement

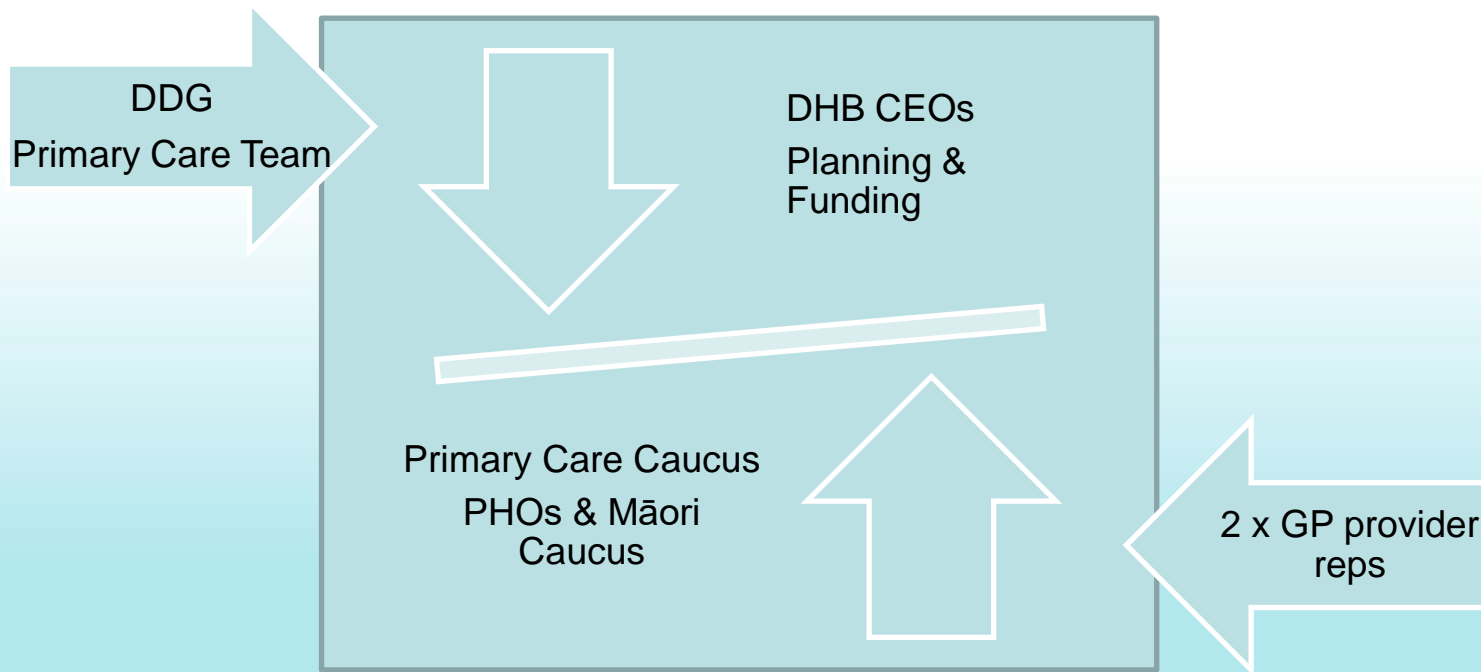
However:

- It is envied

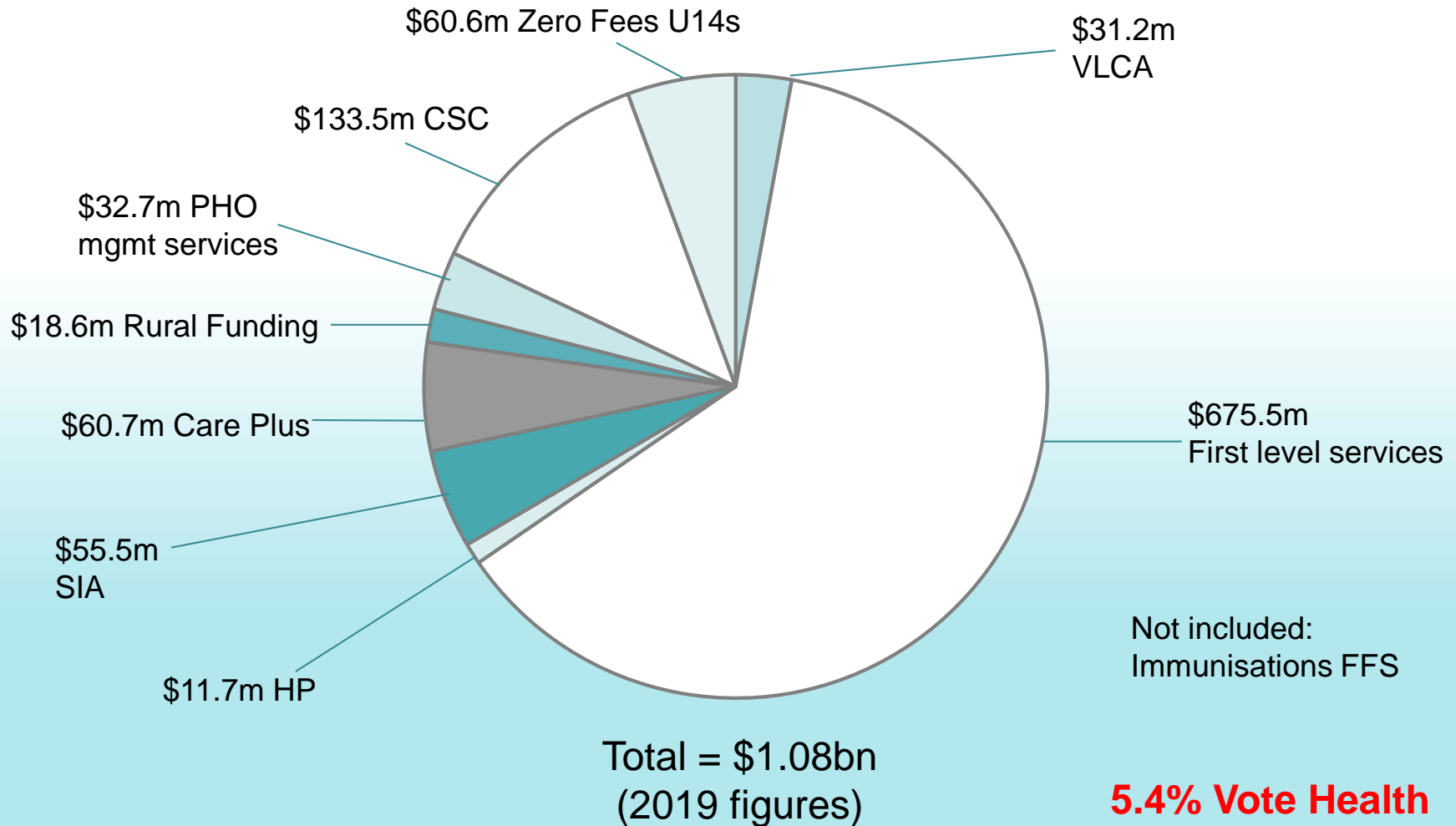

Mostly Local Contracts (some nationally led)

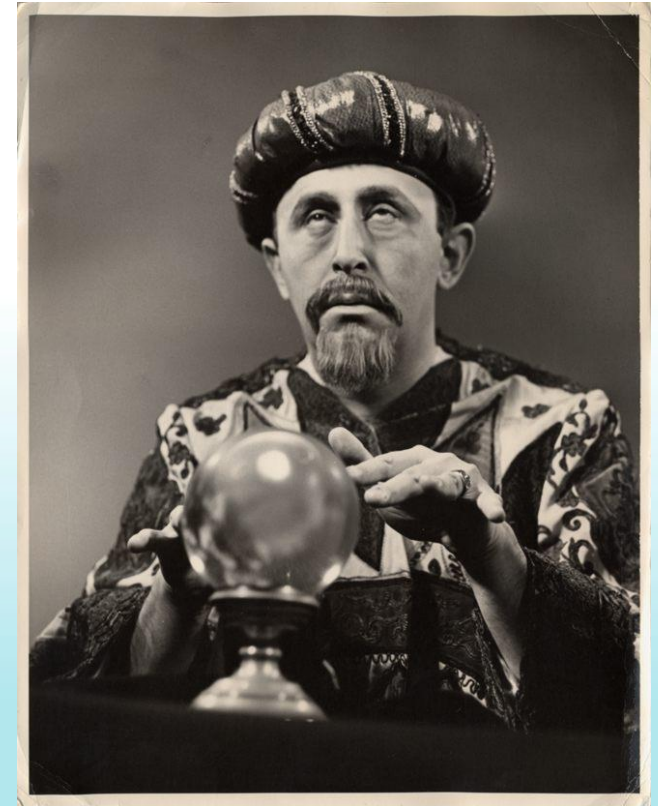
- POAC / CPO / Planned Care
- System Level Measures
- Alliance agreements
- Flexible funding
- After hours
- ACC / MSD / Education / Corrections
- etc
- **COVID**

PSAAP Work Programme

- 4 meetings per year (or 5 or 3...)
- Increased funding for complexity
 - Increasing capitation for Māori, pacific, Q5, 65+ as proxy for complexity
- Planned care
 - Resources, training and opportunity to provide more services in the community
- ASRFI
 - Annual process for increasing capitation
- Other
 - Covid, Gender, Imms schedule, IT issues etc

The Future of PSAAP

- Beyond the PHO Services Agreement?
- Broader general practice services?
- Tier 1 contracting?
- Direct to provider?
- Commissioning for outcomes?
